

Terms and Conditions EBF Conference 2024



Conference Business Participants

<u>Business Participant</u>: the natural or legal person with whom an agreement has been made with respect to participation in the EBF Conference 2024.

EBF Conference Executive Board 2024: the organiser of the EBF Conference 2024.

General:

1. These Terms and Conditions are part of all agreements concluded between the EBF Conference Executive Board 2024, hereinafter referred to as 'organisation', and a Business participant to which these conditions apply, to the extent that the parties did not explicitly and by letter deviate from these terms and conditions.

Article 1: Cancellation Business participant

- The participant has the possibility to cancel the registration. Cancellation takes place by
 e-mail or by registered letter. The participant should send the cancellation to the address
 provided by the organisation. The cancellation has to be received before the 27th of
 September 2024. Delay in the transmission and receipt will be at the expense and risk of the
 participant.
- 2. For cancellations after the 27th of September 2024, the participant is obliged to pay the full invoice amount. The assessment of the cancellation period will be based on the date of the postmark or date of receiving the e-mail. In case the participant terminates the participation after the start of the conference or does not participate in the conference at all, the participant is not entitled to any refund.

Article 2: Cancellation organisation

The organisation reserves the right to cancel the conference until five workings days before
the start of the conference. The Business participants receive a message as soon as possible
when this is the case. If cancelled, the Business participants will receive the full amount of
money back.

Article 3: Grouping program parts

1. The Business participant can forward his or her preferences regarding which parts of the conference to attend. The organisation reserves the right to group the participants. It is possible that the Business participant is classed in another workshop or masterclass than the one of his/her preference.





Article 4: Program

1. The program is at any time without prejudice. The organisation is not responsible for deviations in the program and possible damage which thereby arises for Business participants or other stakeholders.

Article 5: Access

- 1. The organisation reserves the rights to deny Business participants at the entrance of the conference, when the organisation thinks that the Business participant misbehaves or dresses inappropriate.
- 2. The dress code at the conference will be 'Business Formal'. Business participants are expected to dress appropriately.
